
He plans to continue in the teaching profession.







Cross Country


It was a year of hard work for both the tennis and cross country team.





Basketball Team Puts In Hard Season








Golden Wrestlers Place 6th




Speech And Industrial Arts Students Receive Awards



Prom Features Garden Of Versailles Theme










Graduation Outdoors

Brooks Field was the outdoor setting for the 1968 Commencement Exercises of Golden High. 270 Seniors were graduated in the evening ceremony.


























