




Mr. Wood spends much of his free time talking to students. Here Sophomore Brenda Hartness is asking him a question.





Difficult Year For Tennis And Cross Country


It was a year of hard work for both the tennis and cross country team.




David Braden is shown participating in Cross Country meet.



Basketball Team Puts In Hard Season



Golden Wrestlers Place 6th



Julie Meehan Wins Coors Scholarship












