
# . . . Mr. John Chapman





Coach Hafling's tennis "bums" piled up an outstanding four-win, three-loss record despite the inexperience of the players and the huge amount of bad weather early in the season.



The Cross Country team of '66 again upheld the fine record of Golden High. They placed 7th in the League Relays, 5th in the League Championships, and 18th in the State Championships.


In the Aurora Invitationals, Golden placed 2nd with 36 points between Wheatridge with 11 points and Alameda with 38.
